INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING REGISTRATION APPLICATION

APPLICANT PLEASE NOTE – I certify that the information submitted on this document is true and correct to my knowledge and I agree to abide by the rules set forth by the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR. If there is ever a question about the age of this animal, you must agree to have said animal inspected and/or mouthed to verify its age. Remember – The information contained on this application will be used as documentation for the registration certificate. **BE SURE YOU ARE CORRECT** on the spelling of all names, registration numbers, the complete foaling date, and the accurate description of the animal.

1. **ELIGIBILITY OF AMHA REGISTERED HORSES** – Any horse registered with the American Miniature Horse Association, may be registered with AMHR. (Correct fees and proof of registration must accompany this form.) Record the current owner of record on the AMHA certificate as the animal's current owner.
2. **TEMPORARY** – Any horse, not registered with the AMHA, must have a sire and dam registered with AMHR to be eligible to be registered as Temporary until they are three years of age. Application for PERMANENT status will be accepted after the animal has reached its actual 3rd birthday. At that time, the size of the horse will determine whether it is permanently registered as an A Division Horse or a B Division Horse. The size requirements are as follows:
 - A. The horse will be permanently registered a Division A Horse if it measures 34" or under.
 - B. The horse will be permanently registered a Division B Horse if it measures over 34" to 38".
3. **FOR PERMANENT STATUS:** Measure the horse from the last hairs at the bottom of the mane to the ground.
4. **SIGNATURE OF OWNER** – Owner, or owner's authorized agent must sign the application. Owner Signature Card must be on file with the AMHR office.
5. **FOALING DATE** – Give month, day, and year.
6. **NAME OF ANIMAL** – Two name choices are requested in case one name has already been taken. Names cannot have more than thirty-five (35) letters, including spaces and punctuation.
7. **SEX** – Circle whether the horse is a STALLION, MARE, OR GELDING (include gelding date).
8. **NAME AND NUMBER OF SIRE AND DAM** – Give COMPLETE name of sire and dam and their AMHR registration numbers.
9. **COLOR** – Please be specific and use accepted equine colors—bay, brown, black, etc.—“Dapple” or “Roan” are markings – not colors. Be sure to indicate mane and tail color. Below are some suggestions for color:

BAY --	Chestnut or sorrel with black mane & tail and black points
BROWN --	Sometimes difficult to distinguish from black or dark bay, but can be decided by taking careful notice of the fine hairs on the muzzle, must have brown mane and tail.
BUCKSKIN/GOLDEN DUN --	Black mane & tail and usually black points; sometimes black dorsal stripe
CHESTNUT --	Dark mahogany red or dark reddish-brown; mane & tail usually same color, may be flaxen
CREMELLO --	Lightest dun-body hairs seem a uniform cream color
DUN --	Dominant hair is some shade of yellow from mouse color to golden; mane & tail may be lighter or darker than Body; often has dorsal stripe.
GREY --	Some greys are born blue or almost black with more white hairs appearing with age until nearly white
GRULLO --	Smooth grayish-blue color like a mouse-not a blue roan-always has black mane & tail, usually black lower legs
PALOMINO --	Bright gold (color of newly minted \$20 gold piece)-white or light mane & tail
RED DUN --	A dun with a reddish cast to coat; a red mane & tail and often a red dorsal stripe
ROAN --	Produced by intermingling of white hairs with any color
SORREL --	Reddish or copper-red coat, mane & tail usually same color, may be flaxen
WHITE --	Pure white-may have white eyes and pink skin (these are called albinos)
10. Submit 4 current photographs of the animal (1) Full profile/side view of left side; (2) Full profile/side view of right side; In either right or left side photo the horse's head must be turned toward the camera with the forelock pulled back to show face markings or lack of. (3) Full facing forward frontal view; and (4) Full rear view. All four legs must be seen from both sides; markings on face must be visible. All photos should include all parts of the animal available in that view (ears to hooves or nose to tail inclusive) and be unobstructed by any other object or animal. Photos must be a minimum of 3" X 5" and a maximum of 4 X 6". Scanned, digital or computer generated photos, if they are received on photographic paper, are acceptable. Additional photos should be submitted to verify markings not seen in the standard four photos (i.e., white on belly, markings under mane area, etc). Label each photo with first choice of name and owner's name on the back.
11. **BREEDER** – Owner of the dam at the time of service.
12. **SERVICE CERTIFICATE** – Must accompany all applications if the owner of the dam does not own the sire. A Service certificate is available from the AMHR office or website at www.shetlandminiature.com.
13. **STALLION REPORTS** – Must be filed each breeding season. Current year stallion reports are due on or before January 15th of the next year.
