



## AMATEUR PARTICIPATION: EARN \$500 PONY BUCKS!

NEW IN 2025: You can earn Pony Bucks when you enter amateur classes!  
*Prizes to awarded for the inaugural contest at the 2026 Convention (need not be present to win) and at subsequent conventions so long as the program remains active.*

### How does the program work?

- One winner per type (four winners total)--\$500.00 each:
  - ASPC
  - AMHR
  - ASPR
  - NSPPR
- At every show where you enter an amateur class, you earn a chance/ticket with each animal to win Pony Bucks at year end. Tickets are per show per type (ASPC, AMHR, ASPR, NSPPR) (not per individual class). Entries are electronically tracked; you as an exhibitor need do nothing. .

For every horse/pony you enter amateur, you win one chance to win per type (regardless of number of classes entered with that animal. *See examples in fn.1, below*). Area Nat'l Shows award double tickets.<sup>1</sup> The program runs during the competition year (ending December 31 per the standard show year) so that the drawing can occur at the next Convention (*e.g.*, 2025 show year ends 12/31/25 with awards to be drawn and occur at the 2026 Convention).

- Drawing: A drawing will be held at the annual convention gala to choose the winner. Need not be present to win (but you'll want to be 😊) First awards take place at the 2026 Convention.

<sup>1</sup> "Tickets" may be electronically generated and will be chosen randomly at annual conventions.

#### Examples of qualifications:

- A. My Little Pony shows in three Classic amateur classes (such as showmanship, western country and carriage) at a regular breed show: 1 ASPC ticket. My Little Pony adds a NSPPR amateur class: 1 additional ticket for NSPPR.
- B. My Little Pony shows the same classes at an Area Nat'l Show. These offer double tickets, so MLP's ammy garners: 2 ASPC tickets; 2 NSPPR tickets.
- C. The Amateur shows a miniature in several AMHR amateur classes and a pony in several APSC amateur classes: TWO chances to win entered for the drawing at the end of the year—one in the AMHR drawing; one in the ASPC drawing. If at an Area Nat'l Show, the total for this example would be 2 AMHR chances and 2 ASPC chances.
- D. The amateur shows five horses/ponies in one or more amateur classes each= FIVE chances to win from the regular show, assigned by type. Same scenario Area Nat'l Show: ten chances to win assigned by type.
