Proposed rule change:

Wording from ASPC Website:

To achieve Hall of Fame status, A Shetland, Miniature, Show Pony or National Sport Performance Pony must score 70 points in Halter or Performance, and the show record must include five Grand Championship/Stake wins with competition. A horse could achieve Hall of Fame recognition in both Halter and Performance if requirements are met. Hall of Fame points are not given for Model, Amateur, Color. See a list of all classes that receive Hall of Fame point -Appendix B of the 2015 Rulebook. Hall of Fame Award Recipients for the year will be posted by the end of November.

There is no change of wording from the rule book. I would like to point out that in Appendix B none of the AMHR Carriage Classes are listed (1559 Carriage Driving, 1560 Precision Driving, 1561 Carriage Reinsmanship, 1562 Carriage Working, 1563 Carriage Timed Obstacle/Cones, 1564 Carriage Stakes). Yet on the Hall of Fame Points website page Carriage is listed singularly and points are awarded from all of the Carriage Classes under that single heading. I propose to add the following categories for Hall of Fame points as follows:

1559 Carriage Driving/ 1564 Carriage Stakes -HOF Carriage Driving 70 points with 5 Stake wins

1560 Carriage Precision Driving -HOF Precision Driving 70 points

1561 Carriage Reinsmanship -HOF Reinsmanship 70 points

1562 Carriage Working - HOF Working 70 points

1563 Carriage Timed Obstacle/Cones -Timed Obstacle 70 points

Reason for Rule change:

Only 1559 Carriage Driving qualifies an entrant to exhibit in 1564 Carriage Stakes.

1560 Precision Driving, 1561 Reinsmanship, 1562 Working, 1563 Timed Obstacle/Cones are all judged on different and separate criteria than Carriage Driving/Carriage Stakes and each also require differing levels of ability and skill, (i.e Hunter/Jumper/Showmanship etc) and should be recognized for their achievement. It is very disheartening to exhibit the skill used in Reinsmanship and receive the same credit for a basic Carriage Driving Class.
