Proposed Rule Change (provide desired language and intent of rule):

F. The Stewards Committee shall develop, establish and review the measuring protocol for all major ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Shows (i.e. Pony Congress, AMHR Miniature Nationals, all National Area Shows). This protocol will address what procedures will be followed at these shows for horses presented to the Stewards for measuring. This rule does not override the current measurement protocol, but it allows the Stewards Committee to create procedures to aid in the control of flow and educate at the show and allow for a smooth and systematic flow of measuring.

Reason/Justification for Rule Change (provide brief description of why this needs changed/added)

We found that the process and procedures used at the 2020 AMHR Miniature Nationals were very effective in processing the animals that needed to be measured. The Stewards Committee should be involved in this process and in coordination with the Show Office to ensure that all exhibitors and animals are measured timely, fairly and within the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR guidelines.
