The American Shetland Pony Club, Inc. Announces Greatest Show Horses for 2017

Morton, IL – Permanent, lifetime championship status has been given to the greatest show horses and producers of show horses for 2017 by the American Shetland Pony Club, Inc., which includes the American Shetland Pony registry, American Miniature Horse Registry (AMHR), American Show Pony Registry (ASPR), National Sport Performance Pony Registry (NSPPR) and American Shetland Pony International Registry (ASPIR).

Hall of Fame (HOF) is a points-based system administered and maintained by the American Shetland Pony Club, Inc. Points are earned at approved shows, taking into consideration not only actual placing in a class, but the number of entries in that class. HOF points are cumulative and stay with the horse throughout his/her entire life.

To achieve HOF status, a Shetland, Miniature or Show Pony must score 70 points in Halter or Performance and the show record must include five Grand Champion wins with competition or five Performance Champion/Stake wins with competition. For Silver Hall of Fame, 140 points and 10 Stakes or Grand Champion wins are needed. Gold Hall of Fame is achieved when reaching 250 points and 20 Stakes or Grand Champions.

A mare is designated as a Superior Dam when she has produced two HOF offspring and a stallion becomes a Superior Sire when he has six HOF offspring.

All HOF owners must be a current member in good standing with the American Shetland Pony Club, Inc.
